FIRE BAN 2020

The **Alberta government** has issued a **fire ban** that covers almost 60 per cent of the **province** in an effort to prevent wildfires amid the COVID-19 pandemic. The **ban**, announced Tuesday April 14/20, takes effect Wednesday April 20/20 and includes **Alberta's** Forest Protection Area as well as **provincial** parks and protected areas and we have been directed by our Leadership to abide by it, therefore our Fire Ban is now in effect and will remain in effect until further notice.

If people continue to start random non-essential fires, we have the support of the Morinville RCMP to assist us to reduce all future incidents and potentially recover some of the costs. Propane and Charcoal barbeque devices are OKAY, we just ask that you take every precaution, make sure you have an emergency plan. If we see smoke we may drive by your place just to make sure everything is okay.
